



CEAS Publication Agreement

(Please sign and return within 30 days)

Agreement made as of <date> by and between the Cornell East Asia Series, East Asia Program, Cornell University, 140 Uris Hall, Ithaca, NY 14853-7601 (“CEAS”) and

(hereinafter referred to as the “Author”)

1. The Author grants to CEAS a nonexclusive worldwide license to publish, distribute, and sell an English language work with original text in all forms and medium of expression now known and developed in the future the following work (version accepted for publication <date> by CEAS):

(hereinafter referred to as the “Work”)

2. The Author will retain the copyright to the Work published by CEAS.

3. CEAS agrees to publish the Work in hardcover and paperback editions.

4. Any change to the above title, and any substantive changes to the Work require written permission from CEAS.

5. The title, cover copy, and cover design of the Work shall be mutually acceptable to the Author and CEAS. If, however, no agreement can be reached between the two parties in a timely fashion, CEAS reserves the right to decide these matters without further consultation with the Author.

6. The Author agrees that he or she is able to license the rights granted to Cornell and that the Work is original and contains no plagiarized or libelous passages. The Author also agrees that he/she has secured permissions required to utilize copyrighted materials included in the Work, at his or her own expense. (Sample release letter and form enclosed.)

7. CEAS and the Author agree that no compensation, honorarium, or royalties are to be paid.

8. With prior arrangement with CEAS the Author is responsible for all copyediting, proofreading, and formatting in accordance with current guidelines. The manuscript guidelines are enclosed. This version will be considered current for six months from the date of this agreement. Copy submitted after this six-month time period may be subject to revised manuscript guidelines, and the Author should contact CEAS for current manuscript guidelines before preparing camera-ready copy.

9. If preparing camera-ready copy, the Author will furnish one camera-ready copy of the Work on paper and a second copy as a PDF file, prepared according to manuscript guidelines that are current as defined above. A third electronic copy will be supplied if the book is formatted in WordPerfect, Word, Pagemaker, or InDesign. If these materials are not submitted within one year of the date of this letter, CEAS may modify or terminate this agreement.

10. The Author will submit sample pages of the Work (both a PDF file and also printed pages) before presenting the camera-ready copy so that the formatting can be checked.

11. Complimentary Copies of the Work will be distributed as follows:

Single author: CEAS will furnish to the Author, free of charge, two hardcover and eight paperback complimentary copies of the Work as first published, plus two hardcover copies provided for the Author to fulfill the copyright law's mandatory deposit requirements with the Library of Congress. *If work is published in hardcover only, author will receive ten hardcover copies plus two hardcover copies for copyright registration.*

Two authors: CEAS will furnish to the Authors, free of charge, four hardcover and ten paperback complimentary copies of the Work as first published, plus two hardcover copies provided for the Authors to fulfill the copyright law's mandatory deposit requirements with the Library of Congress. If work is published in hardcover only, author will receive 10 hardcover copies plus two hardcover copies for copyright registration. *If work is published in hardcover only, each author will receive eight hardcover copies plus main author will receive two hardcover copies for copyright registration.*

Three authors: CEAS will furnish to the Authors, free of charge, six hardcover and twelve paperback complimentary copies of the Work as first published, plus two hardcover copies provided for the Authors to fulfill the copyright law's mandatory deposit requirements with the Library of Congress. *If work is published in hardcover only, each author will receive six hardcover copies plus main author will receive two hardcover copies for copyright registration.*

Multiauthor volumes: CEAS will furnish the author/editor five copies (three paperback plus two hardcover) plus one paperback copy for each contributor. *If work is published in hardcover only, each author will receive four hardcover copies plus main author will receive two hardcover copies for copyright registration.*

12. The Author grants to CEAS the right to respond to requests to copy part or all of the Work. CEAS will charge and retain a fee when copying is allowed.

13. The Author is required to request permission from CEAS to post any portion of the Work on the Internet, or to reprint any portion of the Work, as long as CEAS holds unsold printed copies.

14. CEAS will notify the Author before reprinting the Work in book format.

15. CEAS will notify the Author when the Work goes out of print in book format.

16. CEAS will notify the Author if/when the Work becomes available in digital format. Any digital resource created by Cornell University in the course of this agreement is the property of Cornell University. CEAS will provide the Author with an electronic version of the Work if one is created. The Author may use the electronic version provided in their teaching and research, but other uses of the digital resource, including but not limited to commercial or scholarly reproductions, redistribution, publication or transmission, whether by electronic means or otherwise, will require permission from CEAS.

17. Special provisions:

CEAS may consider printing the title in paperback edition at a later time. The author will be informed if such consideration will be undertaken.
