Thursday, November 5 - "Looking back at "the deck of the ship:" architecture, society and violence aboard the ships of the Dutch East India Company", Richard Guy (PhD Candidate, Department of Architecture, Art & Planning, Cornell University), 12:00PM to 2:00PM, Kahin Center, 640 Stewart Ave, Ithaca.

Van Leur criticized Eurocentric historians for viewing the Indies "from the deck of the ship," but what did that perspective mean and how was it constructed? This paper addresses space, society and violence aboard the ships of the Dutch East India Company, showing the directors' attempts to organize their highly diverse vessels and crews via uniform work and seafaring practices, while relying on largely unacknowledged cultural and spatial traditions.

Sydney Schanberg is a New York Times journalist covering the civil war in Cambodia. Together with local representative Dith Pran, they cover some of the tragedy and madness of the war. When the American forces leave, Dith Pran sends his family with them, but stays behind himself to help Schanberg cover the event. As an American, Schanberg won't have any trouble leaving the country, but the situation is different for Pran; he's a local, and the Khmer Rouge are moving in. Directed by Roland Joffe, U.K., 1984, 141 minutes.

Will this crisis represent a fundamental breakpoint in the economic and political systems of middle-income countries, or merely a temporary setback?
